II - PARTICIPANTS

- 1. Participants are children and adults who practice Karate-Do and respect the competition rules(Cup) based on the WTKF Competition Rules.
- 2. There are no limits of participating athletes from one country/clubs.
- 3. In case of insufficient number of contestants for a particular category (minimum 8 athletes per category), they will be incorporated in another group of similar age and series.
- 4. All countries must bring two flags and their national anthem.
- 5. National Federation must grant each visiting participant as long as it is registered in its own insurance.
- 6. Kata individual competitions for ages <u>7 and under</u>, <u>8-9</u> and <u>10-11</u> will be in the form of a festival, with 4 athletes per group, where every athlete will receive a medal (one first place, one second place and two third places). Other categories, only four awards. Athletes will receive medals: one first place, one second place and two third places.

IV - Competition rules:

KATA

- Kata individual competitions for ages <u>7 and under</u>, <u>8-9</u> and <u>10-11</u> will be in the form of a festival, with 4 athletes per group, where every athlete will receive a medal (one first place, one second place and two third places).
- Kata individual competitions 12 years and older, only four awards: athletes will receive medals: one first place, one second place and two third places by category.
- Categories for ages <u>7 and under</u>, <u>8-9</u> and <u>10-11</u>, free kata choice (the athlete chooses the kata).

KUMITE

- No contact JODAN is allowed in ko-go and shiai kumite in categories from 0 17 years old due to the laws of protection of children (under eighteen years old) in Brazil Estatuto da criança e do adolescente (Statute-law of children and teenagers). If there is contact jodan, hansoku in these categories.
- 18 years old and older, WTKF rule.
- Kizami-zumi Tnudan does not score in ko-go and kumite from 0 17 years old.
- The other points follow WTKF rules.

V-APPLICATIONS & REGISTRATION

Registration

The detailed information of registration will be announced later.

VI - Participation Fee Athletes

The fees depend on the date of registration.

Register early prior to September 21, 2025 and you pay US\$ 50 per person. (only one fee, and athlete can participate in all competitions)

Register by the deadline date of October 21, 2025, the fee will be US\$ 60 per person. (only one fee, and athlete can participate in all competitions)

VII- COACHES

All team coaches must be registered during the Judges and coaches's seminar otherwise they are not allowed to coach or complain during championship. The fee for each coach is US\$ 50 American dollars per coach. All coaches must attend both days of the judges and coaches' seminar to be able to coach during the championship.

VIII - JUDGES

All Judges must attend both days of the Judges and coaches' Refresher Course to be able to officiate during the championship. The fee for each judge to attend the refresher course is US\$ 60 American dollars per judge. Host will provide lunch for registered judges during the two days of Refresher Course. The deadline for Judges Refresher Course registration is October 21, 2025. All Judges must bring their own HAKAMA (black), whistle and clean KARATEGI including navy blue (recommended) or white KARATEGI top.

IX - PHOTOGRAPHER

All photographer must register with the tournament organizing committee prior to championship to be able to take photo during championship. The fee for each photographer registration is US\$ 50 American dollars per photographer.

• If the country already has coaches and photographers registered in the Pan-American or Children, no fee will be charged for them in the Intercontinental Cup.
